## Restarting of Public Worship

Public Masses can start again from the 10th of May.

We have received a letter from Archbishop Farrell with regard to First Holy Communions and Confirmations. He says:

“The public health advice is that ceremonies such as these should not take place at the time of resumption of public worship. I know that parishes and families alike will wish to prioritise public safety.

While celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation for candidates for the current year may be able to take place over the summer, I believe that regrettably, it is appropriate and necessary that celebration of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion for 2021 candidates should be deferred until the Autumn. I realise that this situation may be a cause of disappointment to many families. I trust that they will understand the rationale for this approach. I wish to express my gratitude to our schools for the excellent work which they have done in preparing our children. It is an immensely valuable component of the partnership between family, parish and school.”
